Potential donor (Donation realized: P - Potential donor)

A person whose clinical condition is suspected to fulfill brain death criteria, but is not (yet) accepted as a donor.

Eligible donor (Donation realized: N - No):

A medical and clinical suitable person whit consent to donation who has been declared dead based on neurological criteria as stipulated by the law of the relevant jurisdiction. However no organs has been retrieved for the purpose of transplantation, due to clinical conditions. Incision might have been made.

Actual donor (Donation realized: Y - Yes):

Every donor from whom at least one solid organ has been retrieved for the purpose of transplantation.

Utilized donor (Donation realized: Y - Yes): An actual donor from whom at least one solid organ was transplanted.
