1. 'Sandbox' – Web-based - Living Donor Registry (LDR)

As we presented in the last newsletter all with Scandiatransplant login have the possibility to access a test-point to try out the new user interface for registration of living donor transplantation and information.

To get access to the **test-point** use the following link



This test version is a 'sandbox' with anonymised data, thus you can look around and register what ever you like without affecting the real database.

2. 'Real life' - Living Donor Registry (YASWA)

If you want to register **real data** through the new interface in the **real database**, you can enter the new system in two ways:

1. Use the following link: <https://sc37.scandiatransplant.org>
2. Enter through the old system by the menu 'Living Donor Web Application':

As we warned you in the last newsletter it is now time to close down the access to the old forms in the 'old' system.

From **2nd of July 2012** it will only be possible to access the Living Donor Registry through the new user interface – YASWA.

This means that if you wish to **enter or look up** data related to a kidney transplantation with a living donor **you have to use the new user interface, YASWA.**
