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Updated version of Infection guidelines

The <u>Guidelines for prevention of transmission of infectious</u> diseases from organ donors to recipients have been updated with an additional Covid-19 addendum: 'A case of confirmed transmission of SARS-cov-2 from deceased lung donor to recipient has now been reported (doi: 10.1111/AJT.16532) In view of this, if donor lungs are procured in areas with high rates of SARS-CoV-2 transmission, it is recommended that donor samples be taken not only from the nose and throat, but also from the lower respiratory tract, acquired by bronchial wash using bronchoscopy or by unguided tracheal suction.'

'Fusion to YASWA' software updates

When new versions of the 'Fusion to YASWA' software are launched the user gets notified about updates when they launch the transfer app., we recommend that these updates are installed.

Some centers have had problems with running the updates, due to warnings about the program missing a valid and trusted certificate.



Information about version updates

Different time zones

In the last update we informed about the fact that all time registrations are now stored in the same format in the database, which is Zulu/UTC-time (no summer-adjustments). In relation with each time field in the system we now introduce a 'N/A' checkbox (N/A = Not Available). When you enter a date with a time field it is now obligatory either to enter time or to check the N/A box.

New time N/A checkbox




If you have checked the N/A box and wish to enter time you just uncheck the N/A box and the time field will appear again.

Liver waiting list additional parameters

On patients waiting for a liver two additional variables have been added 'Liver requirements' and 'Max split volume'. The new fields are especially relevant for recipients on the pediatric liver waiting list.


Additional fields for liver requirements



Infection sample date on the waiting list

On all waiting list entries you are now able to enter a sample date on infection tests. The date field is not obligatory, but can for instance help you to keep track of when at patient was tested Covid-19 positive.

Sample date




New STAMP/LAMP QC

Today we have introduced a new check for 'No identified AB in own HLA'.

The QC check is a comparison between all identified antibodies and the recipients own HLA type.

If there is no identified antibodies against own HLA type the conclusion is Yes (No identified AB in own HLA) in green. If identified antibodies are also found as own HLA the conclusion is 'No(specification of which allele)' in orange.





Automated change of urgency

Count down on urgent liver patient

When a liver patient status is changed to high urgent (HU) it should be removed again after 72 hours if it has not already been terminated from the waiting list.

Each day at 09:55 CET a check is done, if a patient has been on the urgent list for more than 72 hours urgency is automatically change to kind request (RQ).

SMS and e-mail is sent to all coordinators, as if the withdrawal was done manually.

Blood pressure in kPa

On deceased donors you are now able to enter both systolic and diastolic blood pressure in mmHg and kPa and there is auto conversion between the two different units. In the overview each center should have 'their own' unit displayed.

Height and weight on deceased donors

The data entry fields for height and weight on deceased donors have been shifted around, so that height comes before weight.

New national rotation lists for Sweden

All users with at tx center relation to Sweden and access to the 'Donor' menu now have access to a new menu 'Sweden rotation'.

This menu gives access to the Swedish rotation lists on liver and pancreas.
