## Hardware/software updated

December 10, 2015 access to the database through the old user interface (SSH) was closed down, however at that time no further changes was made and the system was still being facilitated by physical Solaris servers, with an outdated operating system, Solaris v5.8.

Early yesterday morning January 20, 2016 this was changed and the production database was moved to virtual servers running Oracle version 10g XE and Ubuntu version 14.04.3 LTS as operating system.

This has no effect on how you access or use the Scandiatransplant database, but it is expected to have a positive effect on the performance of the system.

## New liver urgency code

'Kind request' has been part of the liver guidelines for many years, however the status has not been available in the database.

January 19, 2016 Kind request (code RQ) for liver and liver-kidney waiting list was introduced in the database. This is the very first step towards a new SMS and email system, which is meant to replace the current way of faxing between the centers concerning patients on the urgent (and kind request) waiting lists.
