Missing organ usage registration

August 21, 2013 a new quality control was introduced. This new quality check is meant to disclose harvested organs where usage has not been registered in the ScandiTransplant database.

Traceability is one of the main topics in EU directive 2010/25/EU

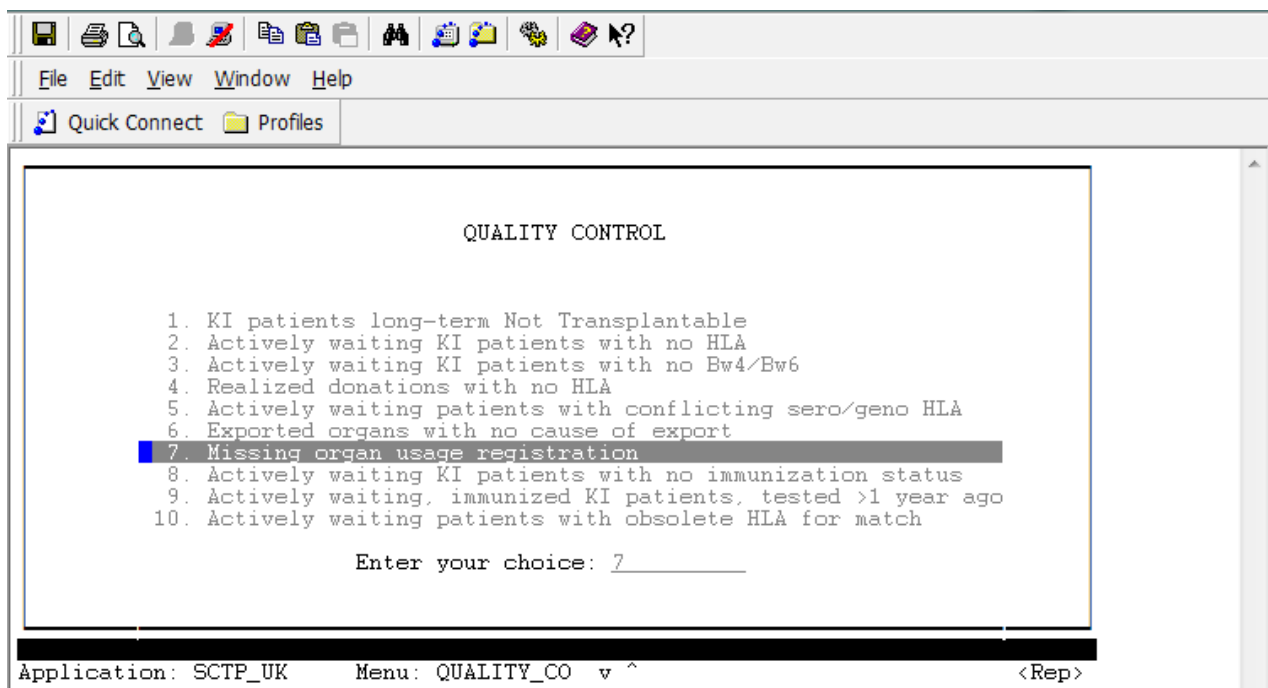

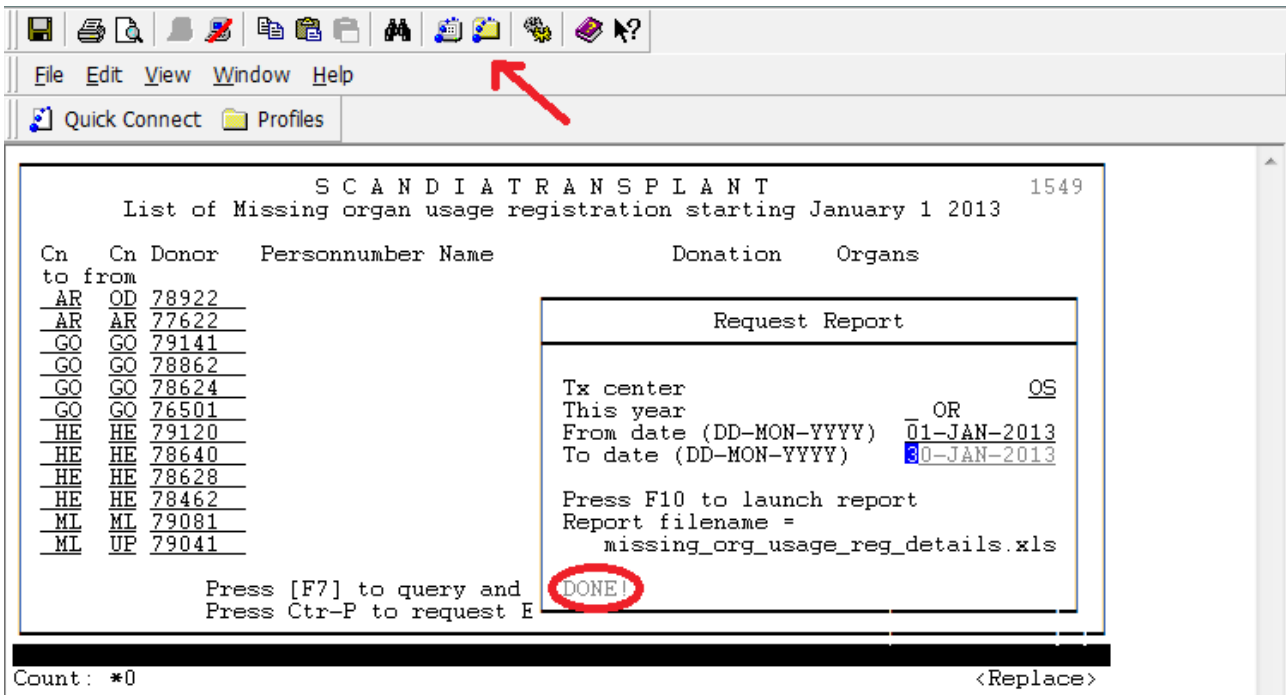
This QC is a tool made for the users, which makes it easy accessible and clear where information about organ usage is lacking.

How to find the new quality control:

Main menu → Quality control → Missing organ usage registration



Press F10 and when the extraction is done find the file in 'New file transfer window' (yellow folder with blue dots).
