**Meeting minutes from last meeting**

**Kidney and liver balance**

All presented had looked through the payback balance in YASWA before the meeting and agreed with current owes and credits.

**YASWA - Payback balance registration**

Everybody is satisfied with the new tool in YASWA, where payback status is displayed.

It is important to register refusal of an offered organ, for later discussions and statistics.

IW demonstrated payback registration, registration of refusals and extraction of the newly introduced reports.

You can even out two exchanged organs, if the centers involved agrees.

### **YASWA - SAE/SAR registration**

IW presented the legislation and argumentation for introducing registration of Serious Adverse Events and Serious Adverse Reactions (SAE/SAR) in YASWA.

It is a tool for the hospitals to report SAE/SAR directly to the competent authorities and to the other hospitals involved.

The report can be sent out acute to all coordinators on SMS and e-mail but will always be sent to CA's before noon each day.

There are now clear definitions of what cases to report, it is up to each center. Definition of SAE/SAR and some overall guidelines are found here:
