

Scandiatransplant security seal

Scope

This document applies for personnel involved in sending and receiving organs. The intention with the security seal is to have a common seal within Scandiatransplant that should be used when transporting organs between centers.

The need for a seal came along with the EU directive of 7 July 2010 concerning quality and safety, as it must be evaluated if the shipping container has been opened.

Usage of the security seal

When transporting organs between centers a security seal must be pasted on the shipping container (or the inner side container with the organ). The seals should be placed so it is not possible to open the container without tampering with the seal.

Usage of the serial number

The center sending the organ must keep the removable serial number, as documentation for use of a security seal. The removable serial number must be pasted on a document that will be archived.
