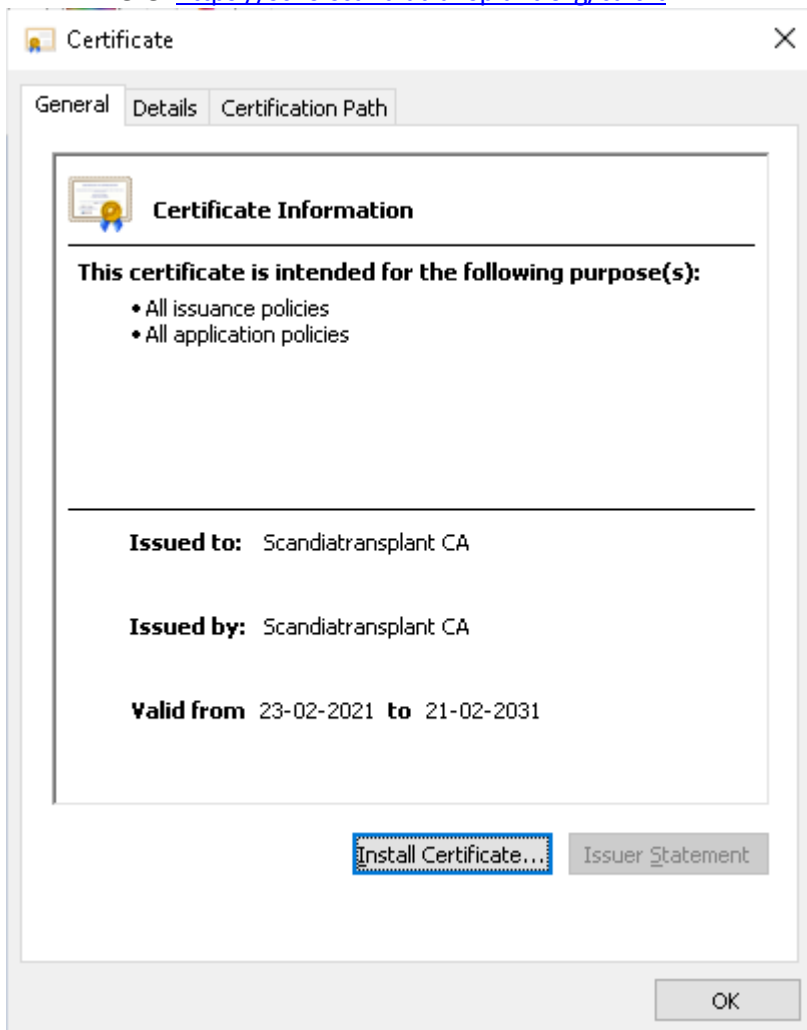


Certificate for 'Fusion to YASWA' software March 2nd 2021

The following instructions are a onetime installation procedure. Administration rights on the client is needed and maybe also help from it staff.

This will ensure that programs signed by the scandiatransplant office is trusted by the client pc and not raise warnings. Initial installation will still be an issue though.

1. Launch the installation file of the main certificate by clicking here: <https://sc40.scandiatransplant.org/ca.crt>



2. Install the certificate on 'Local Machine'
