Traveling to the various transplantation centers has been very rewarding for the study, as unfortunately it has been a rather long start-up phase, much longer than we had expected. This has meant that the individual centers have had a great need for assistance in launching the project.

Finally, in the summer of 2017, it appears that all centers are including patients in the study, and the CRF-files are now being filled in the database and blood samples are getting taken.

We are now there where we can finally say that all 5 transplant centers are included in the study and we start the first analyzes in April 2018.

Evaluation
