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## Report

We visited 2 different Pediatric Intensive Care Units at 2 University hospitals. We focused our time on shadowing nurses and looking at their protocols/ guidelines for commonly used treatments including organ donation and preservation of organs. During our stay at the second hospital we were able to

partake in an actual donor patient. We spent the last 2 days engaged in this process and were able to discuss and go through the guidelines used with respect to donation and preservation of organs.

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## **Evaluation**

We were able to discuss our case afterwards and go through the differences with respect to organ donation and preservation of organs. The US uses outside sources (Life Net in our case) to come into the hospital and discuss donation to the potential donor family. Once the patient is declared “expired”, then Life Net orders the care and organization of the donor. We will be using our experiences in Virginia and present the information to our coworkers. We encourage an open discussion using protocols from both countries and discussing best practice to be used.

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
