### **DPB1** matching in STAMP


In the newsletter from <u>October 2018</u> the new strategy towards DPB1 matching on STAMP/LAMP patients was introduced.

All labs. have now reported back that all patients already active on STAMP/LAMP has been updated with DPB1 acceptable mismatches.

Match on DPB1 in STAMP/LAMP From January 16<sup>th</sup>, 2018

On Wednesday January 16th 2019 DPB1 match will be included in the STAMP/LAMP search algorithm in 'Search for suitable Kidney Recipient'.

Please remember that it has been decided to group/match some of the more common DPB1-types that are not found on the beads according to their G-groups. The current list of these is found <a href="https://example.com/here">here</a> In search it will look like this:



Please remember that due to this solution 'Select calculated' and display of 'DSA' might not work as intended for DPB1.
