All recipients – patient and waiting list administration

One of the most essential parts of Scandiatransplant is ready for test by users from Monday 16th of March. This first user test will run for 14 days until Friday 27th of March.

This module covers

- registration of patient information
- waiting list administration (entry/active/on hold/withdrawal)
- STAMP/LAMP

The test version is a 'sandbox' with anonymized data, thus you can look around and register what you like without affecting real data.

The administration module 'All recipients' will be available from the main menu 'Recipient'.

Search for suitable kidney recipient and urgent waiting lists

Both modules were released in production 2nd of March 2015 on <u>https://sc37.scandiatransplant.org</u>



The shortcut from the 'search result list' to view detailed information on each patient is 'read only' in production, however on the test server the waiting list administration module is writeable.

Access through the old user interface is still kept open, which gives all users the opportunity to do searches and look-ups parallel and along the way learn how to use the new user interface.
