


### Purpose of Scandiatransplant

## Scandiatransplant Office Activities 2013 (1)

- Number 1 priority: Changing to new (YASWA) system:
  - Very crucial due to unsupported software and old hardware.
  - Increased staff with 2 new programmers in summer 2013.
  - Increase user friendliness and functionality.
- Huge amounts of programming and testing done.

- Kept the "old" system running to ensure correct organ allocation 24/7.
- Educated users and complied with demands from users, owners, researchers and the public.
- Arranged meetings for groups, committees, board and council of representatives.
- Participated in meetings with Nordic competent authorities, EU-commission and EU projects.
- Taking care of finance and personnel.

### Scandiatransplant 2013

- 419 Utilized deceased donors (16.04 PMP)
- organ transplants performed

1102 kidneys (347 were living related)

360 livers (5 were living related – 6 were domino)

130 hearts (0 were domino)

137 lungs including heart/lung

87 pancreas including kidney/pancreas

2211 patients on waiting list at end 2013










#### Kidney Transplantation 1989 - 2013






#### Kidney exchange rate 1969 - 2013






### Kidney Transplantation activity 2013 by centre








## Kidney Transplantation PMP 2013










### Kidney waiting list 1995 - 2013






### A verage time on kidney waiting list at end of year






#### A verage Months on Kidney Waiting List by Immunisation status at end year






#### Deceased donor kidney transplants 1994 - 2013

### EXCHANGE CRITERIA Kidney transplantation

- Compulsory exchange of at least one HLA-A,-B,-DR compatible kidney:
  - 1. Highly immunized ( $PRA \ge 80\%$ ) patients who are HLA-A,-B,-DR compatible with donor.
  - 2. Scandiatransplant acceptable mismatch program.
  - 3. Immunized patients (PRA  $\geq$  10% but below 80%) who are HLA,A,B,DR compatible with donor.
  - 4. If organ donor is <40 years of age, at least one kidney is offered to recipient <16 years of age (counted from time of registration), if there is HLA-DR compatibility and in addition not more than 2 HLA-A,B mismatches.</p>
  - 5. Patients who are HLA-A,-B,-DR compatible with donor unless the proposed recipient is >30 years older than the donor.
  - blood group 0 kidneys to blood group 0 recipients.
  - blood group B kidneys to blood group B recipients.
  - Return of another kidney within 6 months.




### Liver Transplantation 1989 - 2013






### Liver Transplants 1994-2013

### EXCHANGE CRITERIA Liver transplantation


- Compulsory exchange to highly urgent patients on waiting list:
  - acute liver failure
  - acute liver re-transplantation
  - highly urgent patients on waiting list must be transplanted within 72 hours
  - Return (pay back) liver to Donor center
- Rota system










### Heart Transplantation 1994 - 2013





### Heart waiting list 1989 - 2013






## EXCHANGE CRITERIA Heart transplantation

- Compulsory exchange to highly urgent patients on waiting list:
  - Patient on short-term assist devices (ECMO, centrifugal pump).
  - Patient on paracorporeal or implantable blood pump with device failure or uncontrollable device infection.
  - patients below 16 years on inotropic supportor more than 12 months support on implantable LVAS.
- Rota system




## Lung transplantation including heart-lung






### Lung Transplantion 1994 - 2013






#### **Lung waiting list 1991 – 2013**

# EXCHANGE CRITERIA Lung transplantation


- Compulsory exchange to highly urgent patients on waiting list (max. tree patients per center per year)
  - Priority 0: Patient on extra-corporeal circulatory support
     (ECMO, Novalung or other device) or ventilatory support\*.
  - Priority 1: Patient with a rapid progression of organ failure with poor prognosis in a short time defined by the responsible centre\*.
