Scandiatransplant

• Scandiatransplant is the organ exchange organization for the Nordic countries Denmark, Finland, Iceland, Norway and Sweden. It covers a population of about 26,6 million inhabitants. It is owned by the ten hospitals performing organ transplantation in these countries. The office is located at Aarhus University Hospital, Denmark.




Purpose of Scandiatransplant

- Effect the exchange of organs and tissue
- Operate a database and communicate information
- Promote the provision of human organs and tissue for transplantation
- Support scientific activities
- Cooperate with national competent authorities, EU, and other transplantation organisations

Scandiatransplant 2015

- 500 Utilized deceased donors (18,77 pmp)
- Organ transplants performed

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1204 kidneys (335 were living related)
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401 livers (5 were living related – 2 were domino)

154 hearts (0 were domino)

141 lungs including heart/lung

2402 patients on waiting list at end 2015






Utilized dceased doners PMP






Flow on the waiting list during a year





Organ exchange between centers in 2015






Kidney Transplantation 1989 – 2015






Kidney exchange rate 1969 - 2015




Kidney Transplantation activity 2015 RANSPLANT by centre






Kidney Transplantation PMP 2015










Number of patients on the Kidney waiting list at the end of the year 1995 - 2015






Average Months on kidney waiting list at end of year






Average Months on Kidney Waiting List by Immunisation status at end year






Deceased donor kidney transplants 1994 - 2015

EXCHANGE CRITERIA Kidney exchange obligations


- 1. Highly immunized (PRA $\geq 80\%$) patients who are HLA-A, -B, -DR compatible with donor.
- 2. Scandiatransplant acceptable mismatch program.
- 3. Immunized patients (PRA \geq 10% but below 80%) who are HLA-A, -B, -DR compatible with donor.
- 4. If organ donor is <40 years of age, at least one kidney is offered to recipient <16 years of age (counted from time of registration), if there is HLA-DR compatibility and in addition not more than 2 HLA-A,B mismatches.
- 5. Patients who are HLA-A,-B,-DR compatible with donor unless the proposed recipient is >30 years older than the donor.
- blood group 0 kidneys to blood group 0 recipients.
- blood group B kidneys to blood group B recipients.
- Return of another kidney within 6 months.




Liver Transplantation 1989 - 2015






Liver Transplantation 1994-2015

EXCHANGE CRITERIALiver


- Exchange obligation to highly urgent patients:
 - acute liver failure
 - acute liver re-transplantation
 - highly urgent patients needs to be transplanted within 72 hours
- Exchange obligation to Paediatric recipients (<18 years at entry on liver waiting list) if donor liver fulfils split criteria
 - Return (pay back) liver to Donor centre
- Rota system for spare livers




Thoracic transplantion 2015






Heart Transplantation 1989 - 2015






Heart transplantation 2015






Heart Transplantation 1994 - 2015





Heart waiting list 1989 - 2015






EXCHANGE CRITERIAHeart

- Exchange obligation to highly urgent patients on waiting list:
 - Patient on short-term assist devices (ECMO, centrifugal pump).
 - Patient on paracorporeal or implantable blood pump with device failure or uncontrollable device infection.
 - patients below 16 years on inotropic support for more than 12 months support on implantable LVAS.
- Rota system for spare organs and more high urgent patients at the same time




Lung transplantation including heart-lung






Lung Transplantion 1994 - 2015






Lung waiting list 1991 – 2015

EXCHANGE CRITERIA Lung


- Exchange obligation to highly urgent patients on waiting list
 - Priority 0: Patient on extra-corporeal circulatory support (ECMO, Novalung or other device) or ventilatory support*.
 - Priority 1: Patient with a rapid progression of organ failure with poor prognosis in a short time defined by the responsible centre*.
 - *max. three patients per centre per year
- Rota system for spare organs and more high urgent patients at the same time
